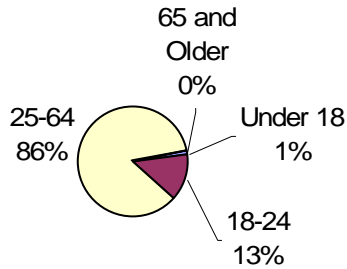

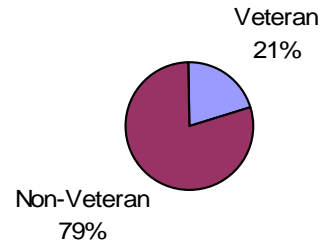
Age of Client



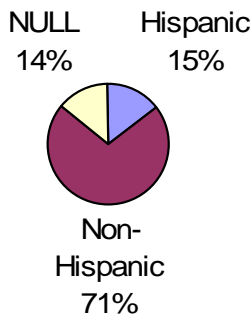
Gender of Client



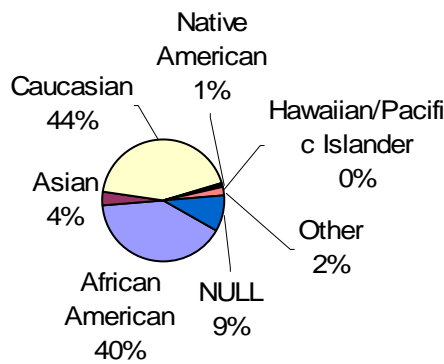
Veteran's Status
