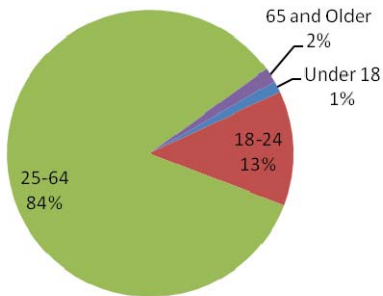

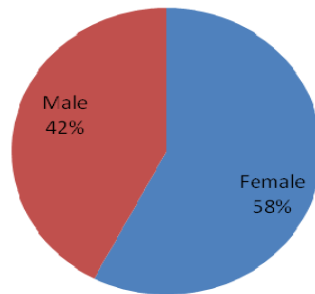

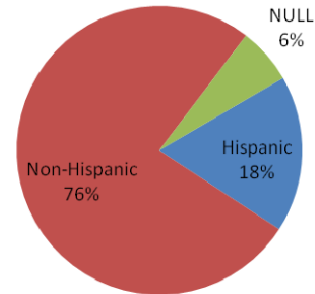
Age of Client



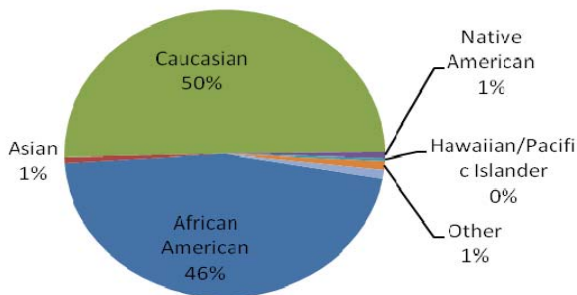
Gender of Client



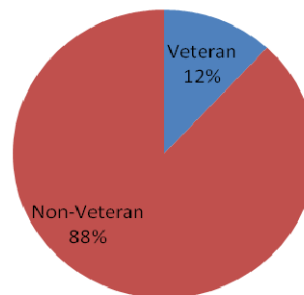
Ethnicity of Client
